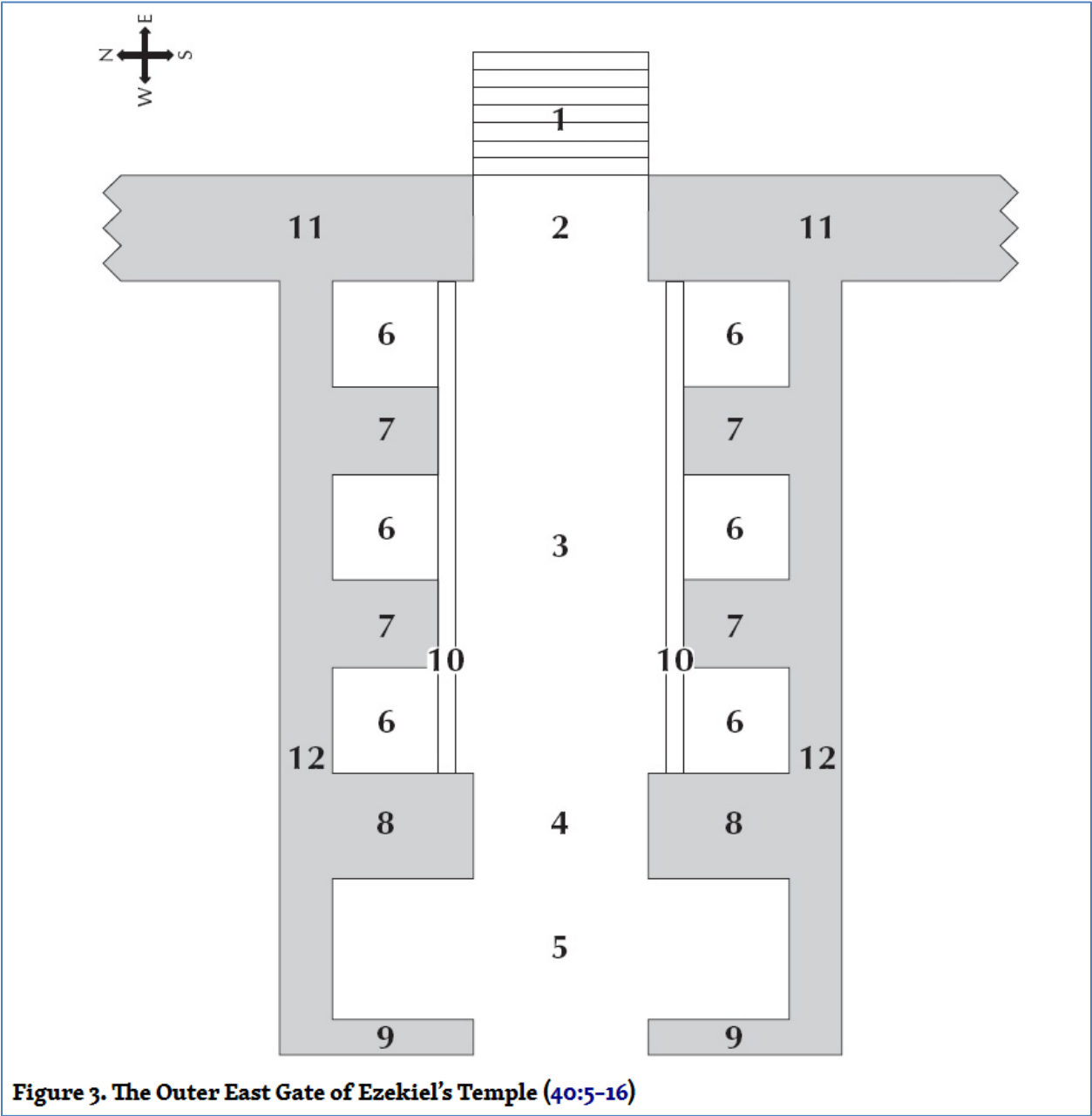


Figure 3. The Outer East Gate of Ezekiel's Temple (40:5-16)

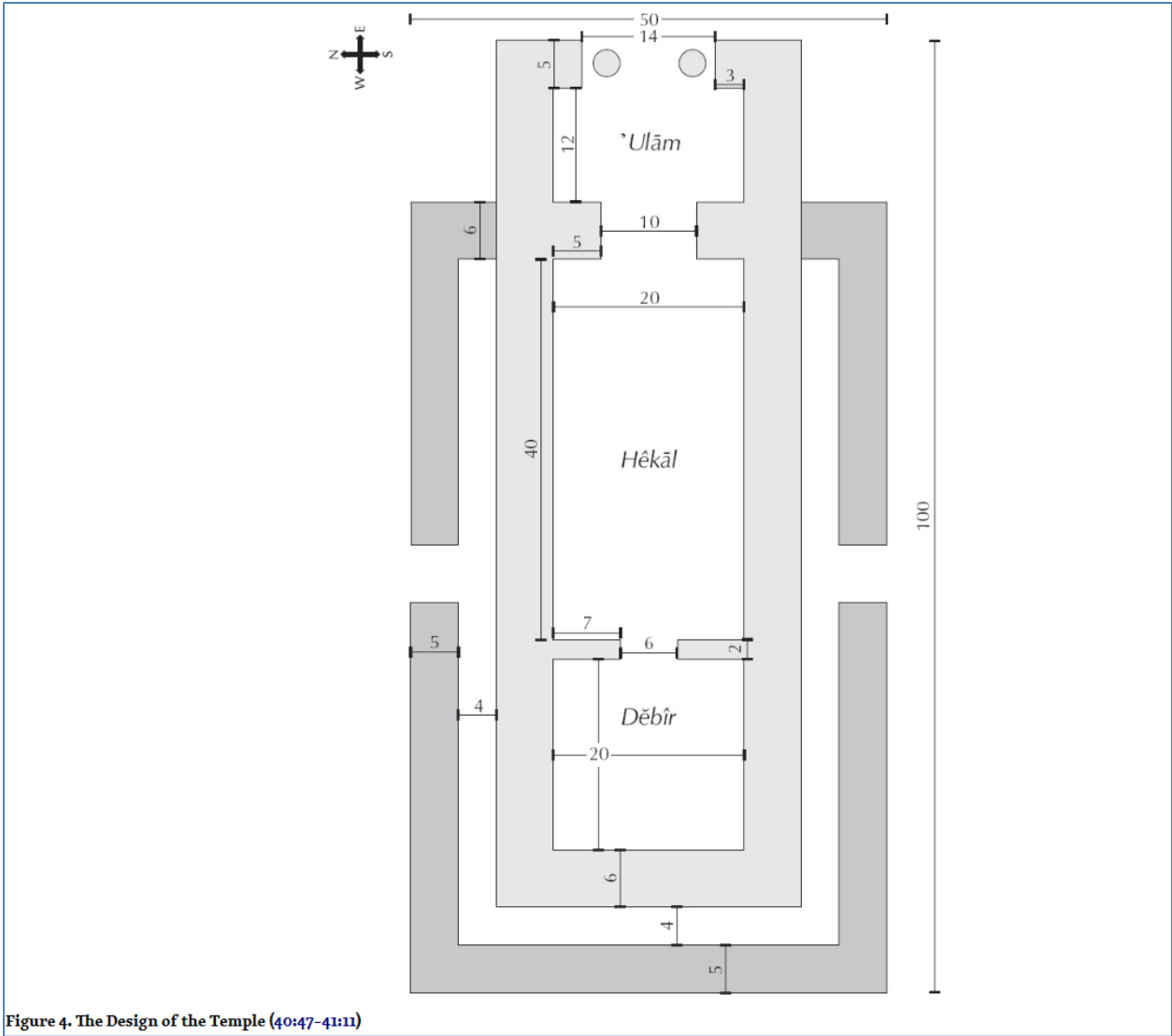


Figure 4. The Design of the Temple (40:47-41:11)

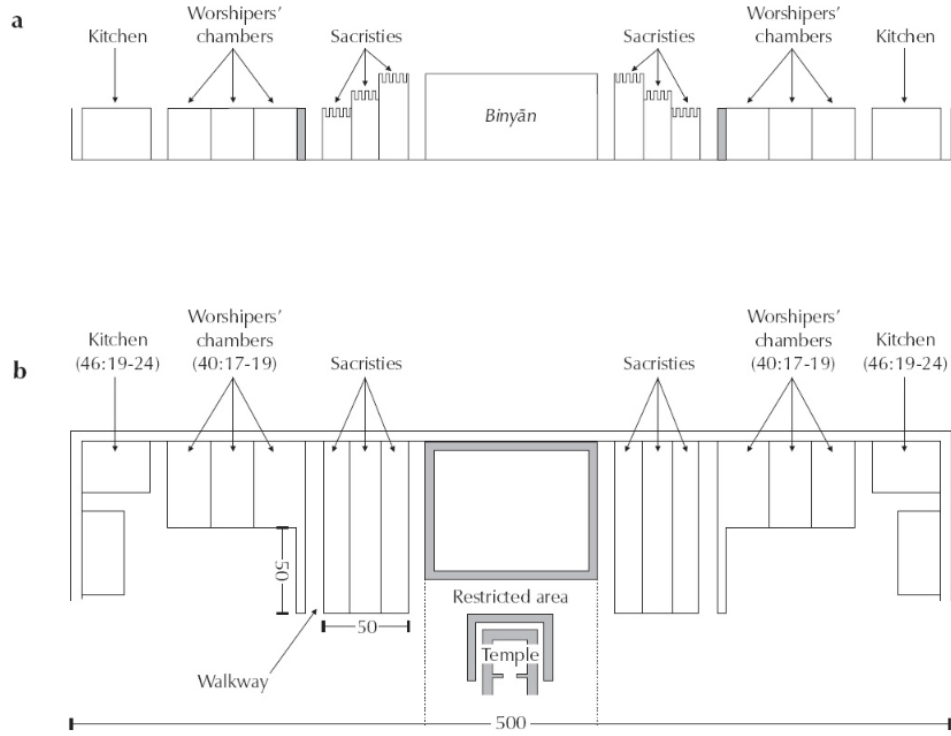


Figure 6. Frontal View (a) and Top View (b) of the West Wall of the Temple Complex (42:1-12)

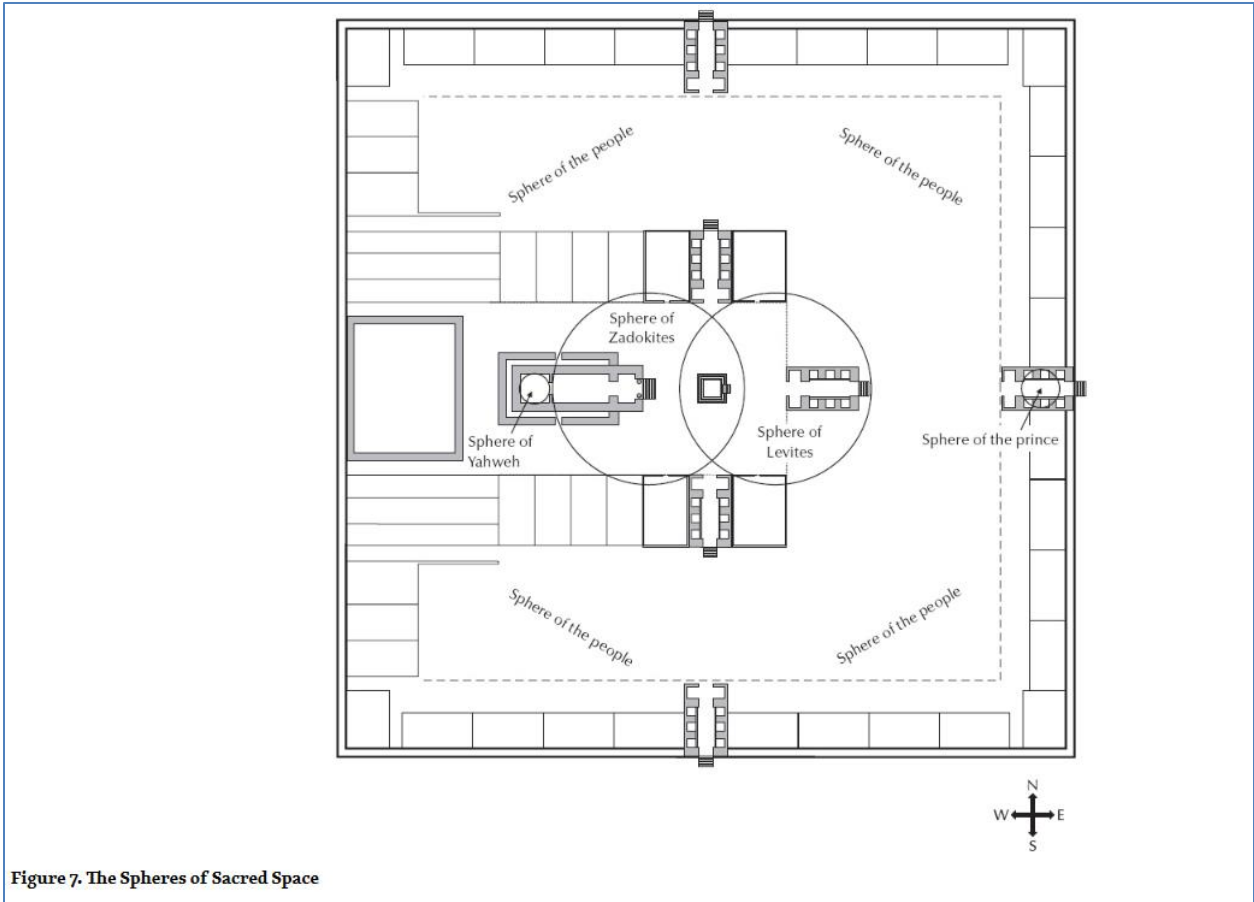


Figure 7. The Spheres of Sacred Space

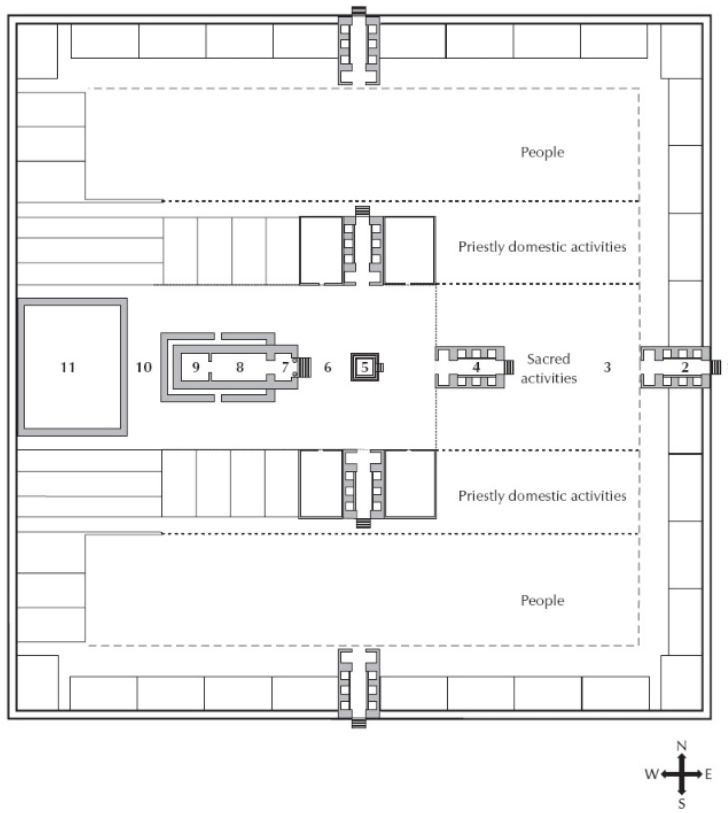
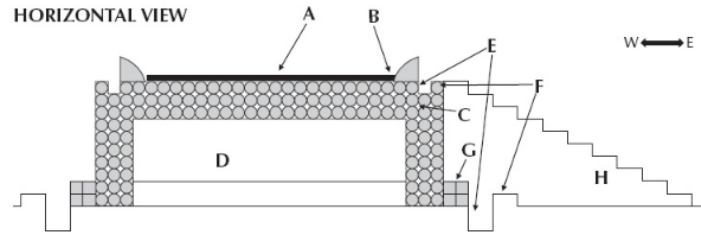


Figure 8. The Spine of Sacred Space

- H Steps (*ma'ālōt*)

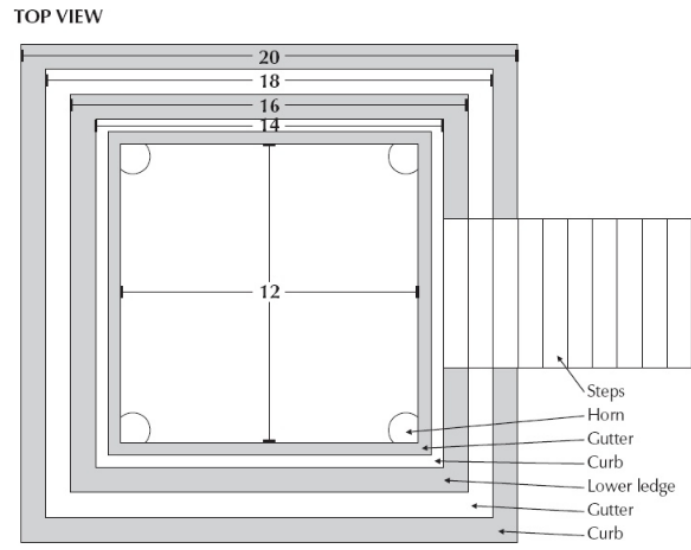


Figure 9. Ezekiel's Altar of Burnt Offerings
